## //TIME & DATE

### SETTING THE TIME

1. In Clock Mode, hold **M** button down until hour starts flashing
2. Adjust hour with **<< or >>|**
3. Click **M** button to confirm hour and minutes will start flashing.
4. Adjust minutes with **<< or >>|** and click **M** button to confirm.
5. Continue to do the same with year, month and day.

NOTE: for 24 hour format click **<< or >>|** in clock mode

## POWER ON and OFF

using power switch on the top of unit.

## 1 MODES

**FM** MODE - HOLD **<< or >>|** to auto seek stations one at a time. CLICK **>||** to sequentially browse "programmed stations." To PROGRAM stations, HOLD **>||** button when in radio mode and local stations will automatically be saved as "P1 thru PXX."

**USB/SD** MODE - In USB/MicroSD ("SCH") mode, insert respective media (USB pen drive or SD Card). CLICK **>||** to play or pause. CLICK **<< or >>|** to select previous or next track/song. "No D" will be displayed if no media is inserted.

**ALARM** MODE - CLICK **<< or >>|** to turn alarm on or off (Bell Chime Icon will appear for "Alarm On.") To set alarm, HOLD **M** until hour starts flashing. Set Alarm in the same way time is set. When prompted for "E1" or "SCH," select E1 for default beep sound or SCH to play any inserted media.

**COUNTDOWN TIMER** MODE - To set countdown timer, HOLD **M** until hour starts flashing. Set countdown timer in the same way time is set. Note: Only hour and minutes are displayed for countdown. Seconds do not show.

## 2 AUXILIARY-IN CABLE

**USING AUX MODE** - Insert the 3.5mm into your playback device (e.g. phone, ipod, etc.) and then insert the USB2 male connector into the BT-92.
